

### New Aboveground Petroleum Storage Tank Installation Rebate Submission Form

### PRE-APPROVAL IS REQUIRED

This form must be completed in full by a participating Oilheat Dealer including project invoice. Submission of the application form constitutes a representation on the part of the participating Oilheat Dealer that the work shown on the form has actually been completed. The Oilheat Dealer must confirm with OHCC staff that funds are available and that the project has been approved PRIOR to the purchase and installation of the equipment.

This form and invoice showing installation of each appliance must be submitted to the Oil Heat Comfort Corp. for the customer to be eligible for consideration of any rebate(s). Failure to furnish all necessary documentation will result in the customer being declared ineligible for consideration of any rebate(s). The Oil Heat Comfort Corp. assumes no liability for a customer being declared ineligible for consideration of any rebate(s). Rebate checks will be paid directly to the property owner by OHCC.

The OHCC UPGRADE AND SAVE – LI Rebate Program is for the installation of a new aboveground heating oil storage tank to replace any existing underground or aboveground storage tank. Aboveground tanks include those located out of doors or inside a property, including basements. It does not apply to any storage tanks installed and buried underground. Oilheat dealer must provide a Fuel Oil Storage Tank Evaluation form for each rebate application submitted. Forms can be downloaded at UpgradeAndSaveLI.com.
